## **BASIC COMPETENCES**

## **SOCIAL SCIENCE 4th ESO**

The student will need to meet the following requirements:

- Interpret the changes and continuities of historical facts during the 18<sup>th</sup> to 21<sup>st</sup> centuries, contextualize them, establish relationships of simultaneity between different territories to understand historical causality.
- Locate and relate in time and space facts or specific phenomena, prominent
  episodes of expansions or conquests, using the conventional forms of dating,
  autonomously, providing great details in its characterization and interpreting them
  effectively.
- 3. Be able to **value the reliability of historical sources**, either primary or secondary. Use those sources and interpret them autonomously.
- 4. **Be able to explain texts or schemes** on specific historical processes of the various periods and establish relationships between them autonomously.
- 5. **Analyse and interpret images or maps** independently using them as historical sources to study the social behaviour or the behaviour of a group, drawing conclusions and extracting consequences.
- 6. **Empathize with historical characters**, correctly recognizes the role they played in the time they lived and explained accurately and widely their actions and their link with the evolution of History.
- 7. **Analyse artistic and cultural manifestations** and relate them to their creators and their time, to interpret the various worldviews and their purpose.
- 8. **Identify a painting or drawing**, describe the scene or the content represented in the work, explain in detail the main characteristics and technical aspects of the work and clearly identify the movement or artistic style to which it corresponds, relating the work with its historical and artistic context.
